## **Revised Visitation Rules and Regulations**

- Current mask requirements will vary in accordance with the presence of COVID-19 in the facility and/or on the community.
- A sign is posted in a prominent place in the atrium to alert all visitors to the current masking requirements.
- When needed, a medical mask that covers both the nose and mouth should be used.
- Upon arrival, visitors will be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19. If you
  have any of the signs of COVID, you will be asked to return on another day for your
  visit.
  - a. It is required that you sign in to the log book in the front lobby and answer the COVID-19 screening questions.
  - b. DO NOT GO TO RESIDENT ROOM OR VISITATION AREA UNTIL you have done this
  - c. If you should test positive for COVID-19 within 48 hours after your visit, please notify us at: 508-473-0435.
- After screening, visitors will go directly to the resident room or assigned visitation area.
- Weather permitting, there are outside areas designated for visitation if you would like to bring your loved one outside. Please be sure to use a space that is not already occupied with other visitors and residents.

## CORE PRINCIPLES OF COVID-19 INFECTION PREVENTION

- Hand hygiene (use of alcohol-based hand rub is preferred). ABHR is available in each resident room and designated visitation spaces. At a minimum, this should be used upon arrival, after each touching episode, and when you leave.
- Mass Department of Public Health strongly discourages visiting a patient or resident is
  on isolation precautions or when a patient or resident has been exposed because of the
  risks involved. If you do visit in these instances, you must be extremely diligent in
  masking correctly, maintaining a distance of 6', and hand sanitizing before you leave the
  room. We strongly encourage you to wear a gown, gloves and an N9 mask.
